Yalta, a relatively undiscovered European gem has plenty to offer not least its breathtaking landscape or fascinating history surrounding palaces, castles and monasteries.

There are not many coastal areas within Europe that can compete with the Crimea's rich history and culture. With a population of about two million and a coastline stretching over 1000 km as well as a certain degree of political autonomy the Crimea almost feels like a country in its own right. Russian is without doubt the dominant language in Crimea in spite of the cultural mix in the region.

### Courses

AMBergh Education offers in cooperation with the leading language school in the Crimea Russian and Ukrainian language education throughout the year, regardless of previous experience, age or even special focus for studies. You can decide when, how long, how intensive and what focus you would like for your studies. It is possible to study other subjects as part of your studies including for example, culture, history, art and music. You really do have the opportunity to shape your studies and can for example choose to study four days a week instead of five should you want more time to explore the region.

### Group courses

If you would like to study with a friend or even family members then we can arrange 'tuition for two'. Alterna-

tively you can choose to study in a group of 3-5 individuals who have the same level of language competence. There is plenty of opportunity within the group courses to adjust the content according to the wishes of the group. The teaching generally focuses on oral communication, listening, reading and writing skills as well as grammar and practical exercises.

### Individual courses

You have the opportunity to choose how much you study if you take an individual course - anything from 15 to 30 lessons (one lesson is 45 minutes in duration) per week. If relevant it is also possible to prepare for internationally recognised language tests and diplomas.

### Accommodation

Accommodation is available in a guest house. Accommodation is generally reserved from Sunday prior to the start of the course until Saturday following the end of the course. Extra nights before and after the course can be arranged at an extra fee.
