### New Technologies for print



Students from St. Petersburg State University have developed a technology for printing plates via laser-induced deposition of metal from solution. New technology allows making very tiny and cheap plates, using small volumes of dilute copper solutions, also making it environmentally friendly. Other young geniuses from St. Petersburg State University developed "Double Defence System", which provides counterfeit and damage protection for various goods during their transportation. DD-system allows controlling long distribution chains and guarantees 100% authenticity of a good.
