### Silver and Bronze to Russia in World Programming Championship

A Team of programmers from Moscow State University won second prize, and St. Petersburg State University took a bronze medal at World Championship of Collegiate Programming. The teams consisted of three programmers, working on one computer. Five hours were given for solving tasks by means of specially designed software. 103 teams took part in the final of the contest, held in Harbin of China. The winning team was from Shanghai.

### Siberian Cranes' Protection

UNEP (United Nations Environment Programme) recently gave a summary of the joint efforts of Iran, Kazakhstan, China and Russia,

aimed at the preservation of Siberian cranes. Every year Siberian cranes fly more than 5 000 kilometres from Russian Siberia to China or Iran, where they winter. Only 3-3.5 thousand Siberian cranes can be found now in wild nature. UNEP's initiative promoted efforts of several countries, of which territories are known to host migration routes of these birds. The mentioned countries have worked hard to preserve and maintain wetlands on the migration route.
